WHAT IS THE COMPASS?

- Untimed, computerized test
- Evaluates skills in:
 - Writing
 - Reading
 - Math
- Determines your eligibility to enroll in GTC courses (starting Fall 2016)

Writing

- Determines if you are ready for entry-level college writing or courses with significant writing loads
 - Ex: ENG 101, ENG 102, PSY 201, SOC 101, etc.
- Asks you to find and correct errors in essays.
 - Punctuation
 - Basic Grammar and Usage
 - Sentence Structure

Reading

- Reading comprehension passages include:
 - Practical Reading
 - Prose Fiction
 - Humanities
 - Social Sciences
 - Natural Sciences

Mathematics

- Multiple choice items in five mathematics areas:
 - Numerical Skills/Pre-Algebra
 - Algebra
 - College Algebra
 - Geometry
 - Trigonometry

Computer Readiness Test

- Basic computer test
- Score is required for GTC Computer Technology courses
- You will take it if you have COMPASS scores of:
 - Pre-Algebra Score of 50+
 - Critical Reading Score of 67+



Criteria/Eligibility to take College Courses

- 3.5 GPA at the end of your Freshman year and 80 and above in all high school classes.
- 2 college courses maximum per semester.
- CPT 170 is required by all GTCHS students with a Computer Readiness score of 90 or less.
 - It is highly recommended to all students as it is a prerequisite course for other GTC courses.

Score Report

- After COMPASS is completed by all 9th graders, the following will be sent home:
 - Score report
 - Additional eligibility and criteria information
 - List of recommended college courses
- Review & discuss this information with your parents.

Important Dates



- **December 15th** – Spring 2016 COMPASS test dates letter.
 - It will include: COMPASS Practice Resources.
- **January 25-28th**- COMPASS administration in World Geography classes.
- **February 1st & 2nd** – Computer Readiness administered at McAlister Square.
- **February 11th**- Follow-up letter with score report and college course recommendation list.
