Early College 2017SP Enrollment Form Instructions

Students indicate their college course requests on the <u>Early College Enrollment Form</u>. Please reference the GTC Course Schedule to ensure accurate requests. Follow these steps to complete the course request section of this form:

- 1. Access the GTC Course Schedule
 - a. Go to http://www.gvltec.edu/course-schedules/
 - b. Choose SPRING 2017 BARTON CAMPUS for Spring courses
- 2. Using the GTC Course Schedule
 - a. In the "Section" column
 - i. Find the course **Prefix** (ex. PSY=Psychology)
 - ii. Find the course **Number** (ex. 201)
 - iii. Find the Course **Section** Number (ex. 001)
 - 1. Do not select a course with a section number of Wxx or 3xx/8xx
 - a. These are online and cohort classes, respectively, in which GTCHS students may not enroll.
 - 2. Do <u>not</u> select a course with a section number of Hxx
 - a. These are honors courses, in which a GTCHS student must be accepted into the GTC honors program.
 - b. In the "Hour" column.
 - i. Find the Credit Hours
 - ii. All courses are 3 credit hours, except for Language and Science courses with labs, which are 4 credit hours.
 - c. In the "Begin-End Times" and "Days" columns,
 - i. Find the class' meeting **Time and Day(s)**
 - 1. Ensure that the class does <u>not</u> conflict with high school classes or Advisory
 - 2. Do not select a Friday/Saturday (1 day) course or a 7 week course
 - d. In the "Building" and "Room" columns,
 - i. Find the Building and Room Numbers
- 3. On the Early College Enrollment Form, fill in items 2a-d in the appropriate columns

Early College Course Selection Policies:

- College courses must fit the high school schedule both semesters
- College courses may not conflict with Advisory period
- College courses must be on the Barton campus
- After-school and evening courses may be selected based upon approval in special circumstances
- Students may not enroll in online and cohort courses; Honors courses only if student is an accepted GTC Honors student.
- Students may <u>not</u> enroll in Friday/Saturday (1 day per week) classes or 7 week classes due to the conflict with the high school class schedule
- Student may <u>not</u> enroll in summer courses until after the completion of the 10th grade year
- Students may <u>not</u> enroll in Maymester/May Mini-mester courses due to the conflict with HS class and exam schedule
- Students may enroll in June or July Mini-mester courses, but it is not recommended

Essential Items on the Early College Enrollment Form:

- 1. The Enrollment Form MUST be LEGIBILE, COMPLETE, and ACCURATE including:
 - a. FULL Social Security Number
 - b. Parent Signature
- 2. Incomplete forms will be returned to students and are due back by the deadline; no exceptions.
- 3. ALL FORMS ARE DUE TO GTCHS School Counseling Department; Late forms will NOT be accepted.

 a. October 7, 2016
- 4. ALL ITEMS listed on the REGISTRATION CHECKLIST must be turned in FOR ACCEPTANCE by the GTCHS School Counseling Department.
 - a. NEW STUDENTS—need to submit <u>Legal Status Verification Form, Identification, and all required</u> documentation with the Early College Enrollment Form.
